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SYNOPSIS

Kate and Carolyn meet Peter Parker (aka Spider Man) and Rodion Raskolnikov, the hero of Dostoyevsky's "Crime and Punishment". They participate in the miracles by Peter and witness the murder by Rodion.

Is Peter the alternative personality of Rodion? Are we experiencing the realization of Dostoyevsky's prophecies? And finally, should we still read the "old" books in order to understand our presence and predict our future?



OVERVIEW

In this documentary essay, two of the most iconic characters in all of fiction appear together for the first time. At first glance they would seem to have little in common. One is a brilliant university student tortured by a nascent conscience after committing a heinous deed. The other is an American high school student who acquires enormous powers after being bitten by a radioactive spider. One is on a mission to prove an asocial theory of morality; the other is on a mission to serve the public by combatting crime. But there's more here than meets the eye. It's a classic case of compare and contrast, and in the process we gain a fresh perspective on these two characters and on ourselves.



















CAROLYN HO

Possessing a strong background in communications and digital media, Carolyn straddles the worlds of pop culture, classic literature, and folklore, with a special interest in Greek mythology. Her favorite writers include Mary Shelley, Charles Dickens, Oscar Wilde, and E.B. White. Her literary passions also encompass Aesop's Fables, Gary Paulsen's Hatchet, and Harry Potter, to name a few.

KATHERINE MARIE PENNEY

An English literature and philosophy major in college, Kate once memorably described going to class as her "drug of choice." Among her favorite philosophers and authors are Plato, Augustine, Kierkegaard, Dostoevsky, D. H. Lawrence, Flannery O'Connor, Slavoj Zizek, and George Saunders. Her favorite filmmakers include Stanley Kubrick, Martin Scorsese, David Lynch, Charlie Kaufman, and Lars von Trier. In November 2018 she moved to LA to pursue a screenwriting career.

PETER PARKER

While still in high school, Peter was bitten by a radioactive spider at a science exhibit. This caused him to acquire extraordinary powers and subsequently led to a part-time career as a superhero.



RODION RASKOLIKOV

A once-promising law student, Rodion is best known for killing pawnbroker Alyona Ivanovna both for her money and to test a pet theory regarding the limits of conventional morality.

PRODUCER AND DIRECTOR:

VITALY SUMIN

Vitaly Sumin is a producer, writer and director, known for *White Nights*, *Shades of Day*, *Notes from the New World*, *The Missing Screenwriter*, and the plurality of the other titles.

After receiving an M.S. degree in Oceanography, Vitaly Sumin produced ocean-related documentaries (Jacques Cousteau style) which eventually led him to abandon his scientific career to obtain a B.A. degree in film directing. He subsequently worked as a co-writer and producer on numerous productions.

Sumin's award-winning short film *From Womb To Tomb*, which he wrote, directed edited, and produced, made a world tour of important festivals.



Following that initial success, Sumin's path diverged slightly - from filmmaking to game development. In 1988, he received a US patent #4,784,394 for *The World Belongs To You!* - an interactive tourist game (including video, reality TV and other versions)

Resuming his film pursuit, Sumin attended the Sorbonne in Paris under a study grant. His script *The Idiot*, which recast Fyodor Dostoyevsky novel as a contemporary international thriller, received a development grant from The Warner Bros Fund. Later Sumin moved to Los Angeles, California, and created VM Productions to develop and produce quality films based on original stories and masterpieces of world literature.

His project *Crime and Punishment, LA* became the winner of the European Co-Production Matchmaking Program, which was featured during the panel at **SXSW**.
